Infant/Child CPR Level B



Description

The Child/Infant CPR course teaches an approach to managing cardiac and respiratory medical emergencies involving infants and children and the skills necessary to render life-saving care until professional help arrives.



Target Audience

This course is appropriate for child care workers and those interested in learning life saving skills including new parents, grandparents, and other family members.



Topics

- Airway, breathing, circulation
- Rescue breathing
- CPR skills
- Sudden Infant Death Syndrome
- Choking (conscious/unconscious)
- Poisoning
- Febrile seizures
- Drowning
- Respiratory emergencies
- Safety and accident prevention



Duration

- 4 hours



Certification

Participants receive a wallet card for CPR Level B.
Certification is valid for one year.
